

Wanna Dance? Summer Dance Challenge FAQ

Who can participate?/Do I need to pre-qualify?

- The Wanna Dance? Summer Dance Challenge is open to everyone! There is no need to pre-qualify!

Who can be a part of the Official Guinness World Record attempt for the world's largest tap dance class?

- The Official Guinness World Record attempt is open to anyone ages 5+!
- This includes dancers, teachers, parents etc.
- All you need is a pair of tap shoes!
- Participation is included for dancers registered for the convention portion of the Summer Dance Challenge, however they must register separately for the class so we can keep an accurate participation count.
- Dancers not registered for convention can sign up for the Official Guinness World Record attempt class independently for only \$10.

Can I register independently or do I need to register with a studio?

- Dancers can register independently!

Who can compete in the 2018 National Soloist of the Year competition?

- Any dancer with two (2) or more solos!
- Soloist of the Year competitors must be registered for the convention portion of the Summer Dance Challenge and will perform the opening number in the 2018 Final Callback Showcase of the Stars Gala taught by our guest faculty!
- Competitors will receive exclusive 2018 National Soloist of the Year apparel.

Where is the Summer Dance Challenge?

- Competition will be held on the Ice Palace at the West Edmonton Mall, large dressing rooms are conveniently located below the Ice Palace.
- Convention classes will be held at the Fantasyland Hotel, located inside West Edmonton Mall.

Who will perform in the 2018 Final Callback Showcase of the Stars Gala?

- Opening number by all Soloist of the Year contestants
- The 3 highest scoring Mini (7 & younger) group/lines (max 1/studio)
- The 3 highest scoring Junior (8 - 11) group/lines (max 1/studio)
- The 3 highest scoring Teen (12 - 15) group/lines (max 1/studio)
- The 3 highest scoring Senior (16 & older) group/lines (max 1/studio)

- The 3 highest scoring Junior (11 & younger) duet/trios
- The 3 highest scoring Senior (12 & older) duet/trios
- The 3 Mini (7& under) Soloist of the Year contestants with the highest average mark with their solo of choice
- The 3 Junior (8-11 years old) Soloist of the Year contestants with the highest average mark with their solo of choice
- The 3 Teen(12-15 years old) Soloist of the Year contestants with the highest average mark with their solo of choice
- The 3 Senior (16-19 years old) Soloist of the Year contestants with the highest average mark with their solo of choice
- 3 Junior(11 & younger) Improv Finalists
- 3 Senior (12 & older) Improv Finalists
